



## *Student Temporary Employment Program 2008*

The *Student Temporary Employment Program (STEP)* is designed for high-school, college, or graduate level students to earn a salary while combining academic study with on-the-job experience. The student must be a U.S. citizen, at least 16 years old and enrolled in a school as a degree-seeking student.

\*This position is temporary. The individual will work full-time this summer through and no later than August 29, 2008. Hiring under the STEP authority will not confer in any way eligibility for permanent employment.\*
