To teach students the obstacles a sea turtle hatchlings face when going on the beach in the wild.

Lesson Duration: 1 hour

Background:

Please read the "Nesting and Predator" handout

Procedure:

- 1. Have students line up along a line in a crawling position. The students are to imitate turtle hatchlings.
- 2. Have four students become predators such as raccoons, sand crabs, or sea birds.
- 3. The object of the game is for the hatchlings to crawl to the other side of the room without the predators eating (tagging) them.
- 4. The predators do not have to crawl, but should act like the predators.
- 5. Once the predator has tagged someone, he or she must wait 3 seconds before going after another hatchling.
- 6. Play this game as many times as wanted with different students as the predators.
- 7. Have class come together and discuss what happened and the difficulties for the hatchlings.
- 8. Also discuss other predators such as *Homo sapiens* who are the most dangerous predators for the sea turtles.
- 9. Give short quiz for last five minutes of class.
